3.	WELCOME AND DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY INTERESTS	
	The Chair welcomed all those present.	
	Under <b>Declarations of Pecuniary Interests,</b> no additional declarations were forthcoming	
	at this time.	
4.	RSC STATEMENT OF INTENT	
	The most recent version of the Trust Statement of Intent had been shared with Trustees prior to the meeting and any direct questions on this version were sought.	
	Q. Are the Trust's strategy around school improvement and the Trust's school by school	
	statements which show Trustees were aware of the vulnerable schools in decline as	
	well as those schools in Special Measures being submitted with the Trust Statement of	
	Intent?	
	A. A large piece of work is being done around curriculum opportunities, mapping	
	resources and so on across the Trust. As this is currently based on one set of visits, it	
	will ideally not be shared yet as it could potentially raise more questions than answers.	
	However, the awareness is there and these documents will be held in reserve below	
	the Trust Statement of Intent.	
	Q. Will that reflect badly on Trustees in terms of accountability?	
	A. The proposals are to address issues in as timely a manner as possible and the Trust's	
	Interim Director of School Improvement is working with other Trusts at pace. The	
	curriculum summary is not part of the Statement of Intent but rather an audit of where	
	the Trust is and what the future might look like. It prioritises key areas so the Trust can	
	take advantage of any available opportunities or funding.	
	It was added that SPi was the gatekeeper of a useful time line that could be part of milestone tracking going forward but that too was not required at this stage.	
	Trustees unanimously <b>approved</b> the Trust Statement of Intent for submission to the Regional Schools Commissioner.	

	Trustee approval was then sought for a number of additional matters shared and discussed prior to the meeting.
